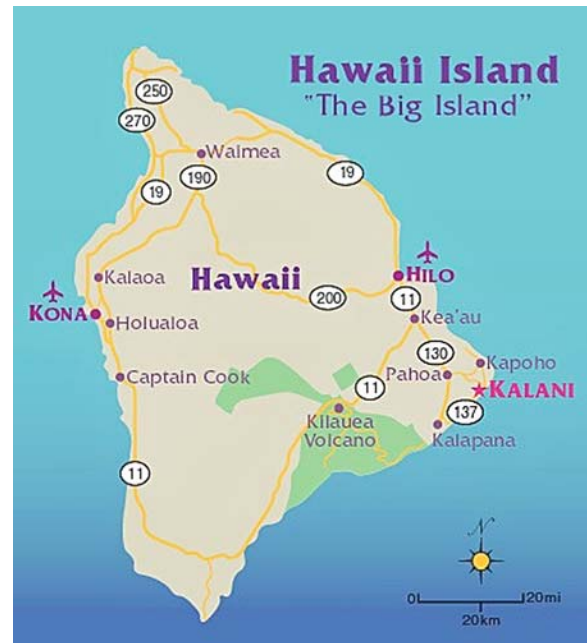




## Getting to Kalani

### From the Kona International Airport (KOA) to Hilo

1. Make a left out of the airport and drive north on **Route 19**.
2. Continue on Route 19 through Waimea, down the Hamakua coast (still Route 19) until you get to Hilo.
3. Past the waterfront side of town, turn **right** onto Kanoelehua Ave/Highway 11 at **Ken's House of Pancakes (sign says Volcano 30 miles)**.
4. Hilo International Airport will be on your left, follow the directions (beginning with direction #2) below to Kalani.



### From the Hilo International Airport (ITO) to Kalani

1. Leaving the Hilo airport, turn left at traffic light onto Kanoelehua Ave/ Highway 11 South.
2. Continue on Hwy 11 until you are out of town (about 5.9 miles).
3. Turn left onto Kea'au Pahoia Bypass Road/ Highway 130 South and continue for 21 miles (passing Pahoia).
4. Just past a green church and in sight of the ocean, a sign will direct you either to Kalapana or End of Road. Turn left towards Kalapana, then curve right.
5. Follow this short road to a stop sign at a T-junction and turn left onto Kalapana-Kapoho Rd/ Coastal Highway 137.
6. After about 5 miles, between the 17 and 18 mile-markers, and a half-mile beyond Kalapana Sea View Estates, Kalani will be on your left, marked with a lighted entrance sign.
