Farm Report:

In recent years both farming use of the Kalani properties and educational programs are combined in this single report to give a complete picture of sustainable agriculture practices, which, by definition “address the environmental, economic, and social issues related to agricultural systems; attempt to ensure that arable land is protected so that current and future generations will be able to farm it successfully; and also seeks to preserve the vitality of family-owned farms and rural communities.”

Please refer to these reports, including the following Land Use, Product Use and Fruit Harvesting reports, to verify that agriculture is the essence and sustenance of Kalani’s operations. And this is not just true to 95% of the properties’ acreage, but also very important for the over 100 farmers, fishermen and businesses that collaborate with Kalani. The agricultural products of the ‘āina — from the food eaten three times per day to the herbs tasted in plant treks, the noni used in wellness and the lauhala in weaving — not only make Kalani survive and thrive, they also are the main eco-tourism attraction and reason why people choose to come to Kalani/Hawaii to attend nearly the same yoga (or other) class that they could more easily take in their nearby North American, European or Asian city. Kalani embraces and celebrates nature, culture and wellness education in an authentic Hawaiian heritage site and context. County Research and Development, The Hawai’i Tourism Authority and the

Kellogg Foundation, have recognized and supported this in recent Na Māla Kalani Cultural Gardens, Ānuenue Freedom Festival, Hawai'i Eco-Tourism Festival grant awards, Puna Music Festival, and Puna Chefs' and Farmers' Culinary Festival awards.

Land use. On the Kalani Honua 19.6 acres, the foundation stamp of each student hale is 2,000 sq.ft. x 4 hale = 8,000 sq.ft. Each faculty cottage is 625 sq.ft x 4 = 2,500 sq.ft. This total 10,500 sq.ft. is less than 1/4th of an acre and represents only 1% of land use. Even some of this 10,500 sq.ft. total could be considered ag, since the 4 hale have classrooms used for learning about arts, wellness and sustainable agriculture. Hence, at least 95% of the property supports agriculture, which includes gardens, orchards, botanicals, pasture, forest preserve, and ag related improvements (greenhouse/maintenance/photovoltaic/water-storage/office/information-center/roadways) all core to ag production/education. [Contrast with County approved ag zoned subdivisions where lots are often strip cleared, and built-to-boundaries leaving little prospect for agriculture].

On Kalani Kai's 94 acres the special use approval is for each retreat cluster/row to have a 3,000 sq.ft. foundation x 13 clusters = 39,000 sq.ft., or less than a one acre footprint, for the entire retreat development. That's 1% of land use. Hence, similar to 19 acre Kalani Honua, at least 95% of the Kai property supports agriculture, which includes nursery, gardens, orchards, botanicals, pasture, forest preserve, and improvements (greenhouse/maintenance/photovoltaic/water-storage/office/information-center/roadways) —all core to ag production/education.

Product use: essential sustenance for sustainable agrarian community.

Following is a 12/31/2010 update for the 3 collaborating educational farms (Kai-Honua-Mauka), managed by non-profit Kalani Honua, Inc., with agriculture utilizing over 95% of each parcel and the combined 120 acres:

Kalani's intent is to expand the properties' organic production — a 1000 year tradition that since 1975 is being furthered with renewed stewardship.

Approved, permitted Farm dwellings provide residency for farm personnel, including farm managers, stewards and assistants. Planned increases in food, medicinal and botanical production require extensive farm help, provided in part with volunteer programs akin to Community Supported Agriculture and World Wide Opportunities on Organic Farms, which involve area and visiting volunteers, who benefit by learning sustainable agricultural, wellness and native practices and by being nurtured by the products of the 'āina.
